This shift has not only added financial strain to patients but has also led to treatment delays and suboptimal outcomes, particularly for diseases like cancer. Rural communities have been disproportionately affected.

To address this gap, Dr. Oidamae Tobiko founded the Africa Integrated Surgical Centre (AISC) in 2021, a multidisciplinary surgical center which is still in its formative stages. At the moment, AISC is run by one specialist surgeon but our goal is to bring on board surgeons from all specialities.



AISC aims to serve as a comprehensive solution for surgical patients in rural and semi-rural areas.

SHORT-TERM GOALS

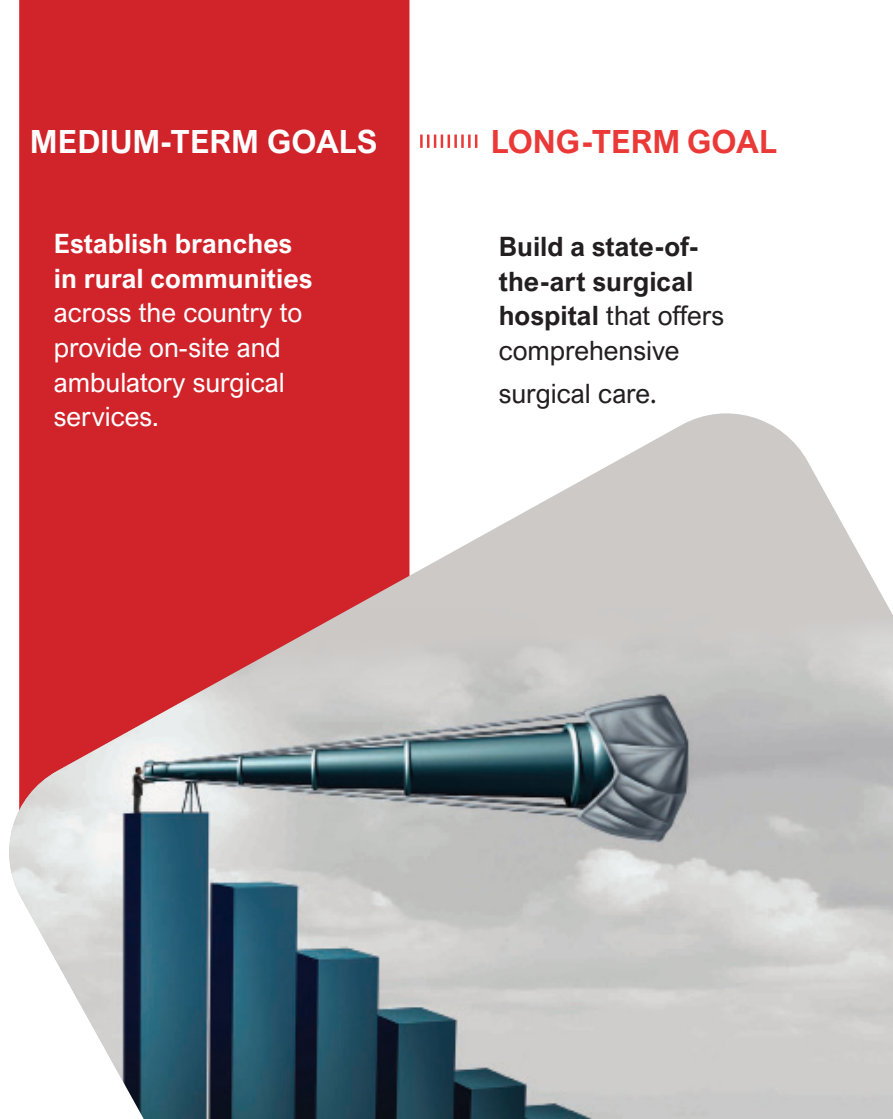
- 1 **Assemble a surgical team** comprising highly skilled surgeons from various specialties, trained both locally and abroad.

SERVICES



1 Adult and Pediatric surgical consultations

Consultation is the cornerstone of medical and surgical management. Successful treatment of any disease starts with an accurate diagnosis. The key to an accurate diagnosis lies in thorough history taking and a comprehensive physical examination.

At AISC, **we firmly believe in the art of effective history taking and a sound physical examination,** as they remain unparalleled in the diagnostic process.

Our comprehensive consultation process for both adults and children include:

- Detailed history taking
- Thorough physical examination
- Interpretation of laboratory and radiological investigations
- Precise diagnosis
- Development of a personalized treatment plan
- Pre-operative patient management and surgical optimization
- Post-operative care
- Rehabilitation, where applicable, to restore patients to their pre-illness state.



2 ENDOSCOPY

Endoscopy, a groundbreaking medical technique, involves the use of a slender camera-equipped tube to inspect or treat diseases within hollow organs or structures, such as the stomach. It has revolutionized the diagnosis and treatment of conditions, notably gastrointestinal cancer.

Our endoscopic services encompass:

- **Upper Gastrointestinal Tract (GIT) endoscopy**, providing insights into the esophagus, stomach, and the initial part of the small intestines.
- **Treatment procedures such as banding of Esophageal varices**, dilatation and stenting, insertion of feeding tubes (PEG), and placement of weight loss gastric balloons.
- **Lower GIT endoscopy (Colonoscopy)** which plays a pivotal role in reducing colorectal cancer mortality.

Colonoscopy, in particular, is a highly recommended investigation, proven to lower the risk of colorectal cancer-related fatalities.

For individuals of African descent, it is advisable to undergo colonoscopy by their 45th birthday

or earlier if there is a family history of colorectal cancer.



3 Breast Care Clinic

Our specialized Breast Care Clinic serves a multifaceted purpose:

- Diagnosis and treatment of benign (non-cancerous) breast diseases.
- Precise diagnosis and surgical treatment of breast cancer.
- Ongoing care and follow-up for known breast cancer patients.
- Comprehensive follow-up care for breast cancer survivors.
- Breast cancer screening, a proactive approach to detect the disease before symptoms manifest.

We place a significant emphasis on breast cancer due to its global impact, affecting not only women but also men. The World Health Organization (WHO) reported a staggering **2.3 million new cases of breast cancer diagnosed worldwide in 2020 alone**

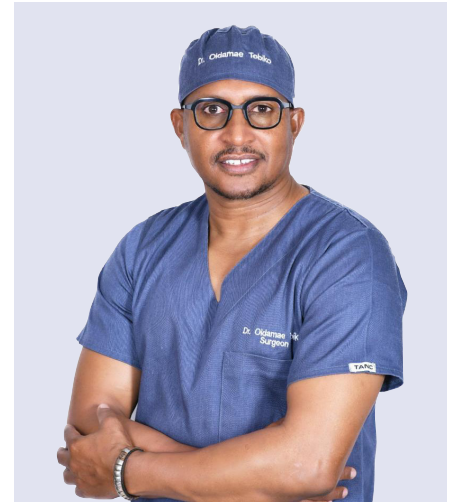
DR. OIDAMAE TOBIKO: Serves as the Head of Clinical Services and Operations.
